Camping for a few nights is a great way to explore Dunk Island. This Information Pack covers most of what you need to know about camping on Dunk Island. But we strongly urge you to read the Department of National Parks, Sport and Racing's website for more information by [clicking here](#).

PERSONAL DETAILS

For safety purposes, all parties must supply a mobile number for a phone you will take to the island.

COST

Standard cost per person is \$6.15 (including GST) per night. The family rate is \$24.60 per night for 2 adults and up to 6 children under 18. Children under 5 are free. [Click to see more](#).

RESERVATIONS

Payment is required in order to confirm your reservation. Whilst our online booking is down payment is made via an automated phone system - where you call a 1800 free call number and use your phone keypad to enter some brief number combinations to make payment.

CAMPING PERMIT

When you have made payment we will receive automatic notification and will then email your Camping Permit which you need to print and take with you to display at your camp site.

CHECK IN / OUT

Check in is at 1pm and check out time is 11am, you can request early check-in or late check-out but this may not be available due to bookings and must be prearranged.

GETTING THERE

You can travel to the Island by private boat, or make the crossing with one of 2 local charter operators. Bookings for charters must be made direct with the operator.

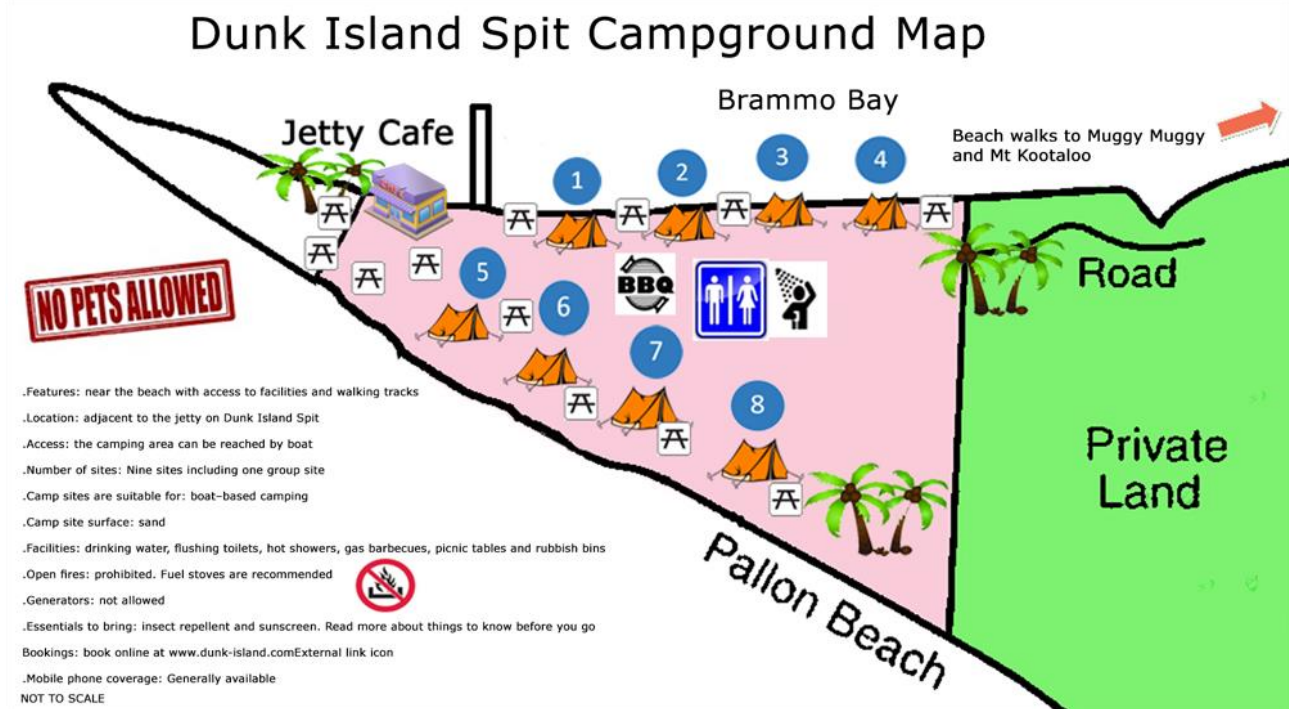

MAP OF THE SPIT CAMPGROUND

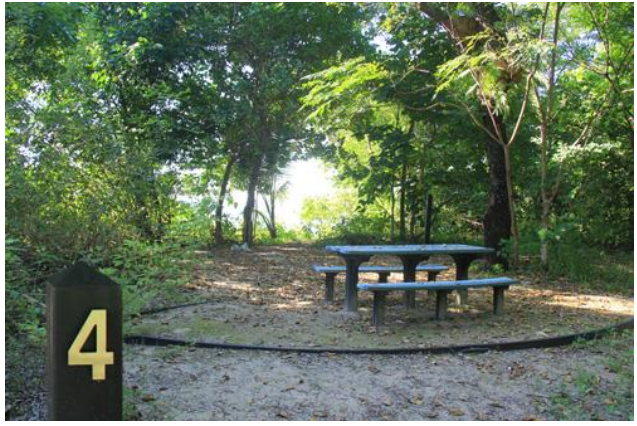


CAMP SITES

There are 8 standard campsites (approximately 10 x 6m in area) which can accommodate a maximum of seven people per camp site. All camp sites are allocated. Photos of the sites are on the following pages. We will try to accommodate your preferences in order of availability. Upon receipt of payment you will be issued with a camping permit which will show your site number. You must camp in your allocated site. Any changes to your booking **MUST** be requested in writing to info@dunk-island.com. The allocation of sites is for your own safety – please keep this in mind and remain in your assigned site.

Each camp site area has a picnic table and 2 bench seats. Sites are not powered however there are power points available at the BBQ area to enable phone charging.





ACTIVITIES

You are able to engage in the following activities at your own risk:

- Walk along the beach and follow the National park trails to Muggy Muggy beach, Scale Mount Kotaloo or take on the Island's circuit track;
- Swim in the ocean (please be aware that marine life hazards exist in the waters surrounding Dunk Island. Marine stingers are most prevalent Oct-May). See link for info regarding Marine Stingers https://www.health.qld.gov.au/poisonsinformationcentre/bites_stings/bs_marine.asp

AMENITIES

- Flushing toilets and hot showers
- Gas BBQs – The BBQ's can be tricky for some people to light. You need to light the pilot light. To do this matches are the best tool. You might like to pack some with your cooking items
- Power at BBQ site
- Potable water

Please keep the facilities as clean as possible for the benefit of other campers.

BAR & CAFE

The Dunk Island Resort operates the Sunset Bar and Café on the Spit offering great meals, ice-cold beverages (Alcoholic and non-alcoholic) and regular live music.

THE DUNK ISLAND RESORT

The Dunk Island Resort has been closed since 2011 due to serious damage sustained during cyclone Yasi. Works are being undertaken on the site to return it to operational status in the near term. We request that all visitors refrain from entering the resort, airstrip and adjoining private lands any time. The private airstrip remains operational, and we request all visitors take care when utilizing the beach at the northern end of the runway.

MEDICAL

Medical or emergency treatment is not available on the island. In an emergency please call 000 and ask for the ambulance service. Please be aware that, if you have a medical condition or suffer an accident while on Dunk Island, it will take an extended period of time for medical assistance to reach you. If you have pre-existing conditions and require daily medication, ventolin or similar please remember to bring this with you as these items are only available on the mainland.

REFUND POLICY

Please note there are no refunds but if for some reason you cannot stay with us, we will change the dates to another time or hold the booking in credit until you can confirm dates for a re-booking.
